

## **SECTION 54. SARSS2B DAILY CATALOG EXTRACT PROCESS**

54.1 General. During normal day-to-day operations, various processes update the User Status Code and the Extract DIC Code on the SARSS2B Catalog Master File (CMF). When the SARSS Master Control System (SMCS) releases the SARSS2B Daily Catalog Extract Process, the process selects all records from the SARSS2B CMF that have User Status Code A, 1, 2, or 3 and writes them to the Transaction-Out File for routing to all supported SARSS activities.

54.2 Interfaces. This process has both external and internal interfaces.

- a. This process interfaces externally with the Logistics Support Activity (LOGSA).
- b. This process interfaces internally with the following:
  - (1) Temporary Corps-Wide File.
  - (2) Transaction-Out File.
  - (3) CMF.
  - (4) SARSS2A Unit Unique Parameter File.
  - (5) Stock Number Relationship File (SNRF).

54.3 Process Overview. This process downloads CMF Records with User Status Code A, 1, 2, or 3 to supported SARSS activities. These supported activities use the downloaded records to update their catalog data. This process informs LOGSA, by means of Document Identifier Code (DIC) CSQ, of records that are being added to the corps-tailored catalog.

54.4 Input. This process uses the CMF.

54.5 Type Processing. The SARSS2B Daily Catalog Extract Process is a batch process that operates when scheduled by the SMCS. Once initiated, it operates to completion without operator intervention. The inputs and outputs are controlled by the SARSS2B Corps/Theater Automatic Data Processing Service Center (CTASC) System.

54.6 Edits. This process has no edits.

54.7 Processing. The following paragraphs explain what happens during this process.

- a. When this process detects a CMF Record with User Status Code A, all CMF Records with a SARSS2B Catalog User Status Code A and Identification Number Code A (NSN) or C (SPN) cause a DIC CSQ add transaction to be sent to Media-Out for LOGSA. LOGSA uses the DIC CSQ to update the SARSS2A Stock Number User File at LOGSA.

- b. For records entering this process, including those discussed in paragraph 54.7a above, the process creates a DIC CPA, CPC, CPD, or CQD transaction, sends it to the Transaction-Out File, and

downloads it to supported activities. These downloaded transactions are used by supported activities to update their Catalog Files.

c. The User Status Code and Extract DIC Code fields on the CMF Records are updated to reflect record status after action required by this process has taken place.

54.8 Output. Output from the Daily Catalog Extract Process consists of the following DICs:

- a. CPA, CPC, CPD, and CQD transactions downloaded to supported activities to update their files.
- b. CSQ transactions downloaded to LOGSA.
