

SECTION 57. SARSS2B INTERACTIVE CATALOG EXTRACT REQUEST PROCESS

57.1 General. The interactive Catalog Extract Request Process lets the SARSS2B manager initiate action to download catalog data (one Catalog Master File [CMF] Record) to all supported activities using the batch Daily Catalog Extract Process.

57.2 Interfaces. This process interfaces internally with the CMF.

57.3 Process Overview. This process lets the manager send a record on the CMF to all supported activities. Any record on the CMF can be downloaded except records that are coded for deletion or those that are inactive. Inactive Catalog Records have a User Status Code of I and are on the CMF but are not on the tailored Catalog File. The tailored Catalog File consists of Catalog Records with national item identification numbers (NIINs) that an activity supported by the SARSS2B is requisitioning.

a. The manager enters the NIIN of the record that is to be downloaded. Entering the NIIN causes the User Status Code and the Extract DIC Code on the CMF Record to be updated. The process changes the User Status Code to 1 and the Extract DIC Code to A. User Status Code 1 means that this CMF Record has had a change and needs to be downloaded. This alerts the process that the record is to be downloaded. Extract DIC Code A means that when the record is downloaded, the process should output a DIC CPA.

b. The batch Daily Catalog Extract Process checks the User Status Code and the Extract DIC Code. Based on the User Status Code 1 and Extract DIC Code A, the process generates a DIC CPA and sends it to Transactions-Out for download to all directly supported SARSS2A and SARSS1 activities. The record to be downloaded is not sent to Transactions-Out until the batch Daily Catalog Extract Process runs. The interactive Catalog Extract Request Process does not result in an immediate downloading of the CMF Record.

57.4 Input. The manager enters a NIIN.

57.5 Accessing the Catalog Update Menu. To access the Catalog Update Menu from the Management Support Menu, move the highlighted bar to the Catalog Update Menu selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, type **CATU** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The Catalog Update Menu (figure 57.5-1) appears.

57.6 Accessing the Catalog Extract Request Process. To access the Catalog Extract Request Process from the Catalog Update Menu, move the highlighted bar to the Catalog Extract Request selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, type **YDE** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The SARSS2B Catalog Extract Request Transaction Build Process screen (figure 57.6-1) appears.

a. The SARSS2B Catalog Extract Request Transaction Build Process screen prompts you to enter a NIIN or stock number and press <Esc> to process the entry.

(1) Enter the NIIN and press <Esc>.

(2) The process searches the SARSS2B CMF for a matching NIIN or stock number. If it finds a match, it updates the User Status and the Extract DIC fields on the SARSS2B CMF Record.

b. The Daily Catalog Extract Process uses this to create and download a tailored Catalog File Record to supported activities.

57.7 Edits. The entered NIIN must be on the CMF. The User Status Code on the CMF must be other than I or C.

57.8 Output. This process updates the User Status Code and the Extract DIC Code for the Daily Catalog Extract Process.
