

SECTION 64. LPN X-REF FILE DOWNLOAD

64.1 General. The interactive Long Part Number Cross-Reference (LPN X-REF) File Download Process lets you download a Document Identifier Code (DIC) YLP transaction for each record on the LPN X-REF File to all or specific supported SARSS2A and directly supported SARSS1 activities.

a. This process requires you to make an entry to specify which supported activity is to receive a download of the LPN X-REF File Records.

b. You can enter ALL for a download to all supported activities, a specific Routing Identifier Code (RIC) for a download to a particular activity, or multiple RICs for a download to selected activities.

c. If you enter ALL, the process will create a DIC YLP transaction for each record on the LPN X-REF File and write it to the Transaction-Out File for downloading at a later time to all supported activities.

d. If you enter a specific RIC for a particular activity or multiple RICs for selected activities, the process checks to see if there is a matching RIC and a Type Unit Code of B-D or 1-7 for each RIC entered on the Department of Defense Activity Address File (DODAAF). Type Unit Code B-D or 1-7 indicates that the RIC is for a SARSS1 or SARSS2A activity.

(1) If it cannot find a matching RIC or RICs on the DODAAF and the Type Unit Code is not B-D or 1-7, the process will display a message on the screen stating that the RIC entered for the LPN X-REF File Download Process does not match the DODAAF. It will then write this same message to the Manager Review File (MRF) with Reason Referred Code M4.

(2) If it finds a matching RIC or RICs on the DODAAF, but the Type Unit Code is not B-D or 1-7, the process will display a message on the screen stating that the Type Unit Code for the entered RIC or RICs is other than B-D or 1-7. It will then write this same message to the MRF with Reason Referred Code M4.

(3) If it finds a matching RIC or RICs on the DODAAF and the Type Unit Code is B-D or 1-7, the process will create a DIC YLP transaction for each record on the LPN X-REF File and write it to the Transaction-Out File for downloading to each of the specified supported activities. It will then display a message on the screen indicating the number of LPN X-REF File Records (DIC YLP) it has sent to the Transaction-Out File for the specified activities.

64.2 Accessing the Catalog Update Menu. To access the Catalog Update Menu from the Management Support Menu, move the highlighted bar to the Catalog Update Menu selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, type **CATU** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The Catalog Update Menu (figure 64.2-1) appears.




Figure 64.3-1. LPN X-REF File Transactional Download Process Screen

64.3 Accessing the LPN X-REF File Download Process. To access the LPN-X-REF File Download Process from the Catalog Update Menu, move the highlighted bar to the LPN X-REF Download selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, type **LPND** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The LPN X-REF File Transactional Download Process screen (figure 64.3-1) appears.

- a. This screen displays several blank data fields where you can enter up to 60 selected RICs. The cursor appears in the first blank data field at the top left of the screen.
- b. The message at the bottom of the screen prompts you to enter ALL for a download to all SARSS activities or a specific RIC(s) for download to a particular activity. It also prompts you to press <F8> to move the cursor to the action line so you can enter a command to exit the process.




Figure 64.3-2. Message Indicating LPN X-REF File Records are Being Output

64.3.1 Downloading the LPN X-REF File Records to All Supported Activities. To download the LPN X-REF File Records to all supported activities, enter **ALL** in the first data field and press <Esc>. The process begins writing the LPN X-REF File Records to the Transaction-Out File for download to all supported activities and displays the screen in figure 64.3-2.

- a. The message on this screen prompts you to please wait as LPN X-REF File Records are being output.

b. When the process is finished writing all of the LPN X-REF File Records to the Transaction-Out File for the download, it displays the screen in figure 64.3-3.

c. The message on this screen lets you know the LPN X-REF File download is complete and displays the number of records output.

d. Press <Enter> to return to the initial entry screen.




Figure 64.3-4. Message Indicating the Process is Checking RICs

64.3.2 Downloading the LPN X-REF File Records to a Specific Activity. To download the LPN X-REF File Records to a specific SARSS activity, enter the RIC of that activity in the first data field and press <Esc>. The process checks to see if the RIC you entered matches a RIC on the DODAAF and displays the screen in figure 64.3-4.

- a. The message on this screen prompts you to please wait as the process is checking the RICs.
- b. When the process cannot find a matching RIC on the DODAAF, it displays a message on the screen informing you, and sends a copy of this message to the MRF with Reason Referred Code M4.
- c. When the process finds a matching RIC on the DODAAF, it checks to see if the Type Unit Code for the RIC you entered is B-D or 1-7.
 - (1) If the Type Unit Code for the RIC you entered is not B-D or 1-7, the process displays a message on the screen informing you, and sends a copy of this message to the MRF with Reason Referred Code M4.




Figure 64.3-5. Message Indicating the Number of LPN X-REF File Records Output

(2) If the Type Unit Code for the RIC you entered is B-D or 1-7, the process creates a DIC YLP transaction for each record on the LPN X-REF File for the RIC you entered and writes it to the Transaction-Out File for downloading to that supported activity. It then displays the screen in figure 64.3-5.

- d. The message on this screen lets you know how many LPN X-REF File Records (DIC YLP) were sent to the Transaction-Out File for download to the activity you specified.
- e. When you see this message, press <Enter> to return to the initial entry screen.
