

SECTION 73. YEB TRANSACTION PROCESSES

73.1 General. The YEB Transaction Process lets SARSS2AC/B managers release and recover previously released DIC YEB transactions. DIC YEB transactions are an output of the Retention Level Review and Management, and Stockage Level Review and Management Processes.

73.2 Interfaces. This process has external and internal interfaces.

- a. This process interfaces externally with subordinate SARSS1s and SARSS2As.
- b. This process interfaces internally with the following files and tables.
 - a. Demand Levels Review Table.
 - b. System User Table.
 - c. Demand Stockage List Code P Table.
 - d. Department of Defense Activity Address File (DODAAF).
 - e. Transactions-Out.

73.3 Process Overview. The following paragraphs explain what this process does.

a. The YEB Transaction Release Process lets you generate DIC YEB transactions for retention levels only, stockage levels only, or both. You can release them for reviewed records only, for unreviewed records only, or for all records.

(1) The YEB Transaction Release Process will only generate and release DIC YEB transactions once.

(2) When generating YEB transactions, the process obtains information from the Demand Levels Review File. This file contains the retention levels and stockage levels, by RIC, that were computed in the Retention Level and Stockage Level Processes which may have been adjusted by the manager using the Interactive Retention Level or Stockage Level Review Process.

(3) For this process to generate YEBs, there must be a record on the Demand Levels Review File that has not been released previously (yeb_ind is N), the SARSS1 RIC must be on the DODAAF, and the RIC-GEO must be the same as yours.

(4) Once the DIC YEB transactions have been generated, the process sends them to the Transaction-Out File for output to the appropriate activity.

(5) The system adds a record for items on the Demand Levels Review File with Manager Stockage Code P to the Demand Stockage Code P Table, unless it is already on that table.

b. The YEB Transaction Recovery Process lets you regenerate DIC YEB transactions that have already been sent. You may regenerate them for retention levels only, stockage levels only, or both.

(1) This process selects only records from the Demand Levels Review File with yeb_ind Y, indicating that a DIC YEB has already been released in the YEB Transaction Release Process.

(2) Use this process if transactions released in the YEB Release Process were lost or for some other reason the batch needs to be reprocessed.

(3) Once the DIC YEB transactions have been generated, the process sends them to the Transaction-Out File.

(4) The system adds a record for items on the Demand Levels Review File with Manager Stockage Code P to the Demand Stockage Code P Table, unless it is already on that table.

73.4 Input. Input for this process is entered by the manager.

73.5 Type Processing. This is an interactive process.

73.6 Edits. The following edits occur:

- a. The entered SARSS1 RIC must be on the DODAAF.
- b. The entered SARSS1 RIC must be on the Demand Level Review Table.
- c. The RIC-GEO for the entered SARSS1 RIC must be the same as the RIC-GEO on the System User Table.

73.7 Processing. The following paragraphs show how this process works.

73.7.1 Demand Levels Review Menu. The commands you need to access the YEB Transaction Release and YEB Transaction Recovery Processes appear on the Demand Levels Review Menu (figure 73.7-1).

73.7.2 Selecting the YEB Transaction Release Process. To select the YEB Transaction Release Process from the Demand Levels Review Menu, move the highlight bar to the YEBR selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, enter **YEBR** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The DIC YEB Transaction Release Process screen (figure 73.7-2) appears.

a. This screen prompts you to enter the SARSS1 RIC. This is the RIC of the activity for which you want YEB transactions released.

(1) Enter the SARSS1 RIC. The system edits your entry to ensure that the RIC:

- (a) Is on the DODAAF.
- (b) Is within your RIC-GEO.

(2) If your entry does not meet these criteria, the system displays an error message.

(3) If the RIC you entered meets these criteria, the cursor automatically moves to the next data entry field.

b. The system prompts you to enter one of three letters to indicate the type of records you want to release: R (for reviewed), U (for unreviewed), or A (for all).

NOTE: You should enter R unless you are absolutely sure that you want to release YEBs for all unreviewed records.

(1) Type the letter that corresponds to your selection in the field next to this prompt, then press <Enter>.

(2) If you leave this field blank, the system displays this error message: "Only 'A', 'R', and 'U' are acceptable entries."

c. Next, the system prompts you to enter one of three letters to indicate the type of level transactions you want released: S (for stockage), R (for retention), or A (for all).

(1) Type the letter that corresponds to your selection in the field next to this prompt, then press <Enter>.

(2) If you leave this field blank, the system displays this error message: "Only 'A', 'R', and 'S' are acceptable entries."

d. Finally, the system prompts you to enter X in the field next to the types of YEB transactions you want to generate: Add, Increase, Decrease/Unchanged, Delete, or All. Enter X in the appropriate fields.

e. Once you complete all data entries, press <Esc>.

(1) If the system finds such YEB transactions to process, it displays these two messages: "Writing output record for YEB transaction" and "Output YEB processing to AJUB0P has been completed."

(2) If the system cannot find such YEB transactions to process, it displays this message: "No output YEB records available for processing."

73.7.3 Selecting the YEB Transaction Recovery Process. To select the YEB Transaction Recovery Process from the Demand Levels Review Menu, move the highlight bar to the YEBRC selection and press <Esc>, or press <F8>, enter **YEBRC** on the action line, and press <Esc>. The DIC YEB Transaction Recovery Process screen (figure 73.7-3) appears.

a. This screen prompts you to enter the SARSS1 RIC. This is the RIC of the activity for which you want YEB transactions recovered or regenerated.

(1) Enter the SARSS1 RIC. The system edits your entry to ensure that the RIC:

- (a) Is on the DODAAF.
- (b) Is within your RIC-GEO.

(2) If your entry does not meet these criteria, the system displays an error message.

(3) If the RIC you entered meets these criteria, the cursor automatically moves to the next data entry field.

b. Since this process only lets you resend DIC YEB transactions that have already been released in the YEB Transaction Release Process, this screen does not prompt you to enter R (for reviewed), U (for unreviewed), or A (for all) to indicate the type of records you want to release. It does, however, prompt you to enter S (for stockage), R (for retention), or A (for all) to indicate the type of level transactions you want released.

(1) Type the letter that corresponds to your selection in the field next to this prompt, then press <Enter>.

(2) If you leave this field blank, the system displays this error message: "Only 'A', 'R', and 'S' are acceptable entries."

c. Finally, the system prompts you to enter X in the field next to the types of YEB transactions you want to generate: Add, Increase, Decrease/Unchanged, Delete, or All. Enter X in the appropriate fields.

d. Once you complete all data entries, press <Esc>.

(1) If the system finds such YEB transactions to process, it displays these two messages: "Writing output record for YEB transaction" and "Output YEB processing to AJUB0P has been completed."

(2) If the system cannot find such YEB transactions to process, it displays this message: "No output YEB records available for processing."
