

SECTION 89. SARSS2B LOCAL SUBSTITUTE NIIN (YBH) PURGE PROCESS

89.1 Type and Frequency of Process. The SARSS2B Local Substitute National Item Identification Number (NIIN) (YBH) Purge Process is a batch process that operates as required when scheduled by the SARSS Master Control System (SMCS). Once initiated, it runs to completion without operator intervention.

89.2 Purpose. This process reads each record on the Local Substitute NIIN (YBH) File to determine whether it should purge it. It purges (deletes) records from the Local Substitute NIIN (YBH) File when the YBH NIIN or NIIN-pointed is on the Stock Number Relationship File (SNRF) or the YBH relationship is not on the SNRF but the YBH record has been on the file for one year without change.

89.3 Edits Performed. When the process runs, it performs a series of edits.

- a. It checks to see if the YBH NIIN and NIIN-pointed match a NIIN and NIIN-pointed on the SNRF.
- b. It checks to see if the YBH effective date is blank.
- c. It checks to see if the system date less the YBH effective date is greater than one year.

89.4 Actions Taken. Based on the results of these edits, the process will either purge or retain the record.

- a. It purges the record from the Local Substitute NIIN (YBH) File if:
 - (1) The YBH NIIN and NIIN-pointed match a NIIN and NIIN-pointed on the SNRF.
 - (2) The YBH NIIN matches a NIIN on the SNRF, the YBH NIIN-pointed does not match a NIIN-pointed on the SNRF, and the YBH effective date is blank.
 - (3) The YBH NIIN does not match a NIIN on the SNRF and the YBH effective date is blank.
 - (4) The YBH NIIN does not match a NIIN on the SNRF, the YBH effective date is not blank, and the system date less the YBH effective date is greater than one year.
- b. It retains the record on the Local Substitute NIIN (YBH) File if the YBH NIIN does not match a NIIN on the SNRF, the YBH effective date is not blank, and the system date less the YBH effective date is less than one year.

89.5 Output. This process creates a Document Identifier Code (DIC) YBH with Transaction Code D (for delete) for each record it deletes and writes it to the Transaction-Out File for each subordinate SARSS2A and directly supported SARSS1 activity. This output is controlled by the SARSS2B Corps/Theater Automatic Data Processing Service Center (CTASC) System.
